PROGRAM MISSION AND GOALS (Revised November 2023)

Mission Statement of the MSU Master of Science Dietetic Internship Program

Mission Statement: The faculty and preceptors of the Michigan State University Master of Science Dietetic Internship (MSDI) Program will strive to prepare entry-level dietitian nutritionists for state-of-the-art practice in diverse and challenging healthcare, foodservice, community, and entrepreneurial settings.

Goals of the MSU Dietetic Internship Program

1. The program will develop entry level registered dietitian nutritionists who demonstrate competence and professionalism.

Outcome Measures:

- a. The program's one-year pass rate (graduates who pass the registration exam within one year of first attempt) on the CDR credentialing exam for dietitian nutritionists is at least 80%.
- b. At least 90% of program graduates take the CDR credentialing exam for dietitian nutritionists within 12 months of program completion.
- c. One hundred percent of MSDI program graduates will have received a minimum of a 3.0 average rating for attainment of core competencies. (5-point scale: 1= unsatisfactory/minimal skills; 5 = excellent/above entry level).
- d. At least 80% of interns complete program requirements within 24 months (150% of planned program length).
- e. The mean of responses to the survey question: "Rate your preparation for the internship for an entry level RD/RDN position" will be at least 3.0 by 90% of responding interns (5-point scale: 1 = unsatisfactory/minimal skills; 5 =excellent/above entry level).
- f. Eighty percent of responding employers will rank program graduates with a mean rating of at least 3.0 (5-point scale where 1=unsatisfactory/minimal skills; 5= excellent/above entry level) on preparation of graduate for an entry level RD/RDN position.

2. MSU MSDI graduates will seek employment in various areas of dietetics.

Outcome Measures:

- a. Of graduates who seek employment, at least 90% are employed in nutrition and dietetics or related fields within 12 months of graduation.
- b. Eighty percent of WIC graduates will continue to work in Michigan WIC for two years after completion of the internship.
