- 4. Successful applicants may be asked from time to time to make an appearance, to present their educational progress, as related to the Scholarships' intentions, to the Foundation or its Membership.
- 5. Applications must be received by January 31, of the qualifying year. (Students qualifying <u>Junior</u> status in the Spring Semester, of that year, will be considered qualified). All applications will be presented to the Steelheaders' Board of Directors.
- 6. Applicants will be notified on or after the Second Wednesday of the month of March.
- 7. Formal Presentation of the Scholarship(s) will take place at our Annual Membership Meeting held on the third Wednesday of the Month of April. Successful applicants will be asked to attend.
- 8. Scholarships generally are based at a minimum of \$2000.00 but, can vary in value, due to year to year fund raising efforts.
