- ALL JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL

• Proof of Negative Coggins within the past 12 calendar months is required for all horses on the fairgrounds. Participants must present a legible copy of current coggins to entry booth, prior to show (will not be returned)

• Rider's age determined as of January 1st of the current year.

• Beginner horse classes are walk/trot only, for inexperienced horses (5 years old & under) that have never shown at the canter, shown by experienced riders.

- Beginner rider is for those who have never shown at any show in canter classes.
- All patterns, including games, will be posted the day of the show.

• Oceana County Fair Board or Oceana County Horse Developmental Committee or anyone associated with it will not be held responsible for lost or stolen property or any injuries to person or livestock while on the grounds. Waivers must be signed before participation. OCHDC and the OCFB are not liable for disease outbreak.

- To be eligible for year-end high point award, the Oceana County 4-H'er must compete at both of the OCHDC shows.
- Any complaints must be made in writing to the OCHDC.

• Horse must be in control at ALL TIMES. At the discretion of the judge and/or the OCHDC, participants may be excused from the arena. The horse may also be excused from the fairgrounds or trailered for the remainder of the day.

• OCHDC has the right to split or combine classes as they see fit the day of the show. Classes with more than 10 participants will be split by back number. Classes with less than 3 riders may be combined with other classes in the ring, they will be judged separately.

• No alcohol allowed on premises. No tobacco or e-cigarettes in any area there are persons or animals present.
