MODEL GUIDELINES

The following are guidelines for providing learning experiences in models.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL MEMBERS:

- 1. Learn model construction.
- 2. Develop an appreciation of modeling as a hobby and a skill.
- 3. Do your best and develop a sense of pride in your accomplishment.
- 4. Exhibitors should have instruction sheets during judging.
- 5. A different exhibit should be made each year showing advancement in skill and difficulty.

Helpful Hints:

- 1. The following supplies may help you during construction: model glue, x-acto knife or single-edge razor blade, rubber bands, needlenose tweezers, paint brushes (fine, medium, and large point), paint, paint cleaner (turpentine), paint rag (paper towel) and a box or case to carry previous items.
- 2. Use toothpicks to help spread glue. Be very careful with the glue.
