## **STENCILING**

The following are guidelines for providing learning experiences in stenciling.

## General Suggestions

- \* Make sure stencil is concise and neat.
- \* Learn what supplies are needed.
- \* Be able to explain to judge why and how the project was completed.

## Beginning (1-2 years in project)

Suggested knowledge/skills to be learned:

- 1. Learn the basic strokes for stenciling.
- 2. Learn how to use the brushes.
- 3. Compare liquid paints versus paint sticks.
- 4. Learn to properly take care of stencils and brushes.

Suggested projects for beginners:

Four special occasion or holiday greeting cards

Simple one, two, or three color wall hanging or small box with lid.

## Intermediate (3-4 years in project)

Suggested knowledge/skills to be learned:

- 1. Continue more advanced application.
- 2. Learn to stencil on clothing, making sure they are clean and pressed if appropriate.
- 3. Try different shading techniques.
- 4. Learn how to stencil on baskets.

Suggested projects for intermediates: Placemats T-shirts Sweatshirts

Advanced (5 years and over in project)

Suggested knowledge/skills to be learned:

- 1. Continue with more advanced projects.
- 2. Learn to develop your own design and cut stencil.
- 3. Become a teen leader.
- 4. Demonstrate a technique and/or develop instructional materials.
- 5. Show and/or sell products at art shows, craft shows, etc.
- 6. Explore career opportunities in stenciling.

Suggested projects for advanced: Home designs & furnishings Floors Bedding Tablecloth/runner Etc.
