#### Michigan 4-H License Plate Proposed



On Tuesday, September 26, legislation was unveiled that if passed, will create a new fundraising license plate that would generate support for Michigan 4-H. State Reps. Matthew Bierlein, of Vassar, and Reggie Miller, of Van Buren Township, sponsored the legislation which would allow for the creation and sale of a Michigan 4-H plate through the Secretary of State.

The plans would create the 4-H fundraising plate and establish regular disbursements from the license plate sales to the Michigan 4-H Foundation. Led by a board of trustees, the foundation works in partnership with MSU Extension and Michigan 4-H Youth Development to support programs to prepare youth for meaningful and productive lives. Please encourage your politicians to adopt this legislation!

#### Join Us at our Halloween Events:


Wexford 4-H will be participating in 3 Halloween events this year. We would love to show up big with 4-H, so please come help us give out candy and


All applications are due by November 1.
