Georgia Boot Trailblazers Contest





MARKET TURKEY ORDERS DUE FEBRUARY 23RD

Youth Market Turkey projects must be ordered through the Northern District Fair Livestock Committee to be sold in the livestock auction. Exhibitors must enter a pen of 2 turkeys, with one selling at the auction.

Youth must also register their project with their club and leaders must submit one market livestock registration form per species per club by February 15 (turkey only).

Why Youth Mental Health First Aid?

Youth Mental Health First Aid teaches you **how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illnesses and substance use disorders.** This 8-hour training gives adults who work with youth the skills they need to reach out and provide initial support to adolescents (ages 12-18) who may be developing a mental health or substance use problem and help connect them to the appropriate care.

WHO SHOULD TAKE IT

- Teachers
- School staff
- · Coaches
- · Camp counselors
- Youth group leaders
- Parents
- · People who work with youth

WHAT IT COVERS

- Common signs and symptoms of mental illnesses in this age group, including:
- Anxiety
- o Depression
- Eating disorders
- Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)
- Common signs and symptoms of substance use.
- How to interact with an adolescent in crisis.
- How to connect the adolescent with help.

The course will teach you how to apply the ALGEE action plan:

- Assess for risk of suicide or harm
- · Listen nonjudgmentally
- Give reassurance and information
- · Encourage appropriate professional help
- Encourage self-help and other support strategies

When we see a kid who is just miserable at school, we might think they choose to be that way — or that it's just part of adolescence. But in fact, they might be in a mental health crisis, one they certainly did not choose and do not want. When a teacher says, 'How can I be helpful?' that is a powerful question."
