

# DETECTING WILDLIFE

Though not required by the FSMA Produce Safety Rule, the use of deterrents can be very effective in managing wildlife presence on your farm

## FENCING & NETTING

Expensive but beneficial in the long run



## RELOCATION

Important to use extra precaution & check state laws

## NOISE DETERRENTS

e.g., air cannons for birds or ultrasonic devices for groundhogs or rodents

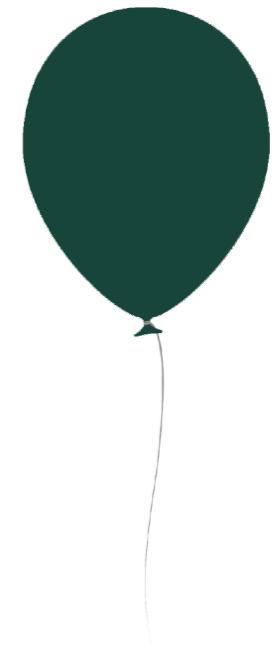
## DECOYS

e.g., plastic coyotes or swan decoys to scare off geese



## VISUAL DETERRENTS

e.g., reflective tape & balloons
