BARRY COUNTY 4-H DAIRY FEEDER CALF SALE

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Barry County 4-H Dairy Feeder Program helps youth explore opportunities within the dairy and beef industries. Through this project, members raise dairy or dairy-beef crossbred steers while building foundational skills in animal care, recordkeeping, project management and responsibility, as well as developing an entrepreneurial mindset.

SALE INFORMATION

Following the show, where 4-H member-owners exhibit their calf projects, these steers will be offered through a silent auction July 20–24, 2026, at the Barry County Fair. Calves will weigh approximately 300–550 pounds and will be grouped and sold in small lots, determined after the official weigh-in at the start of fair week. Sale proceeds go directly to the 4-H members who own the calves. All steers are dehorned, vaccinated and ready for placement in a feedyard.
