What is the difference between a snaffle and a curb bit?



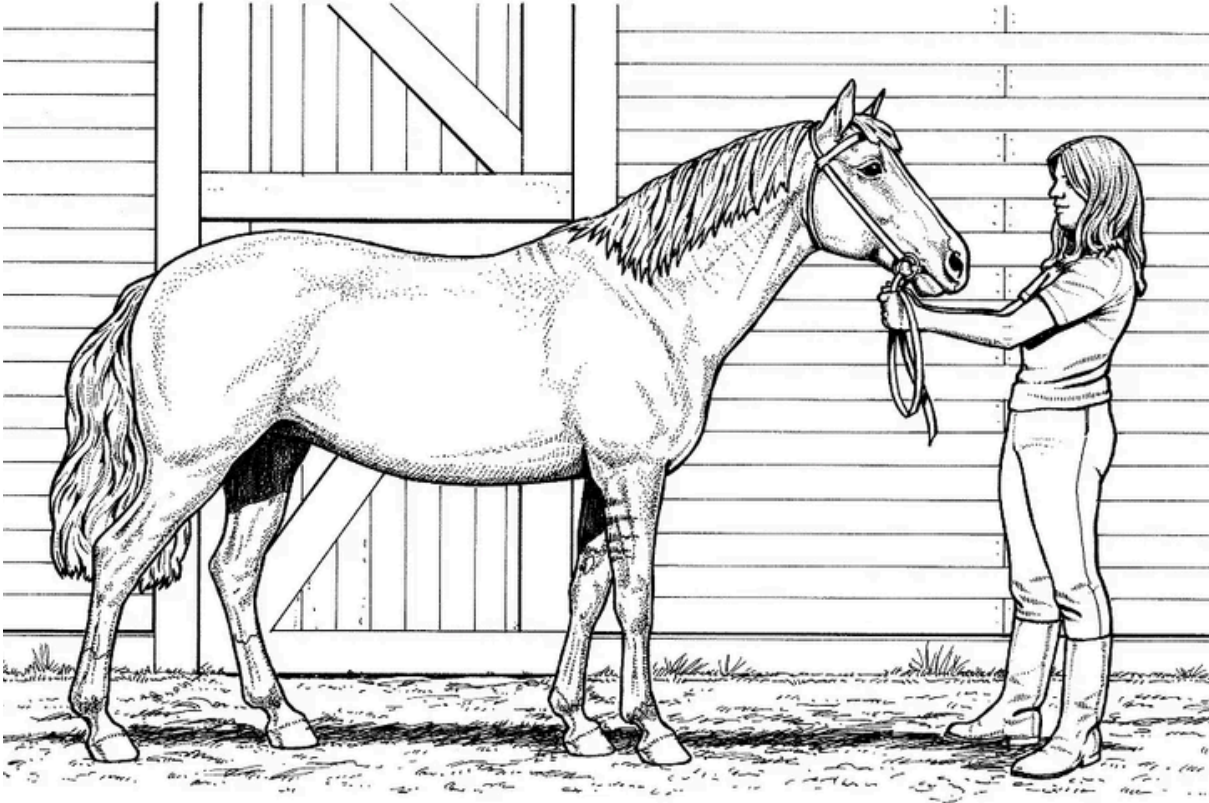

Horses are usually led from the right side

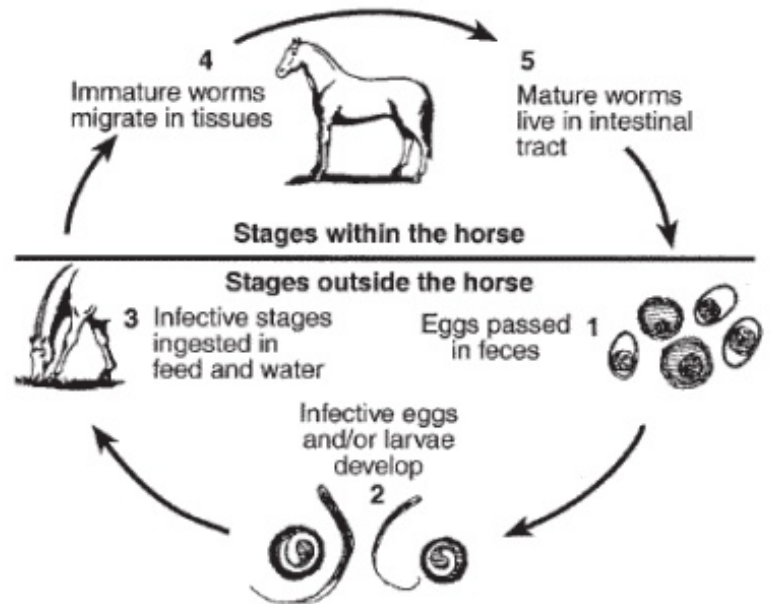
TRUE or FALSE

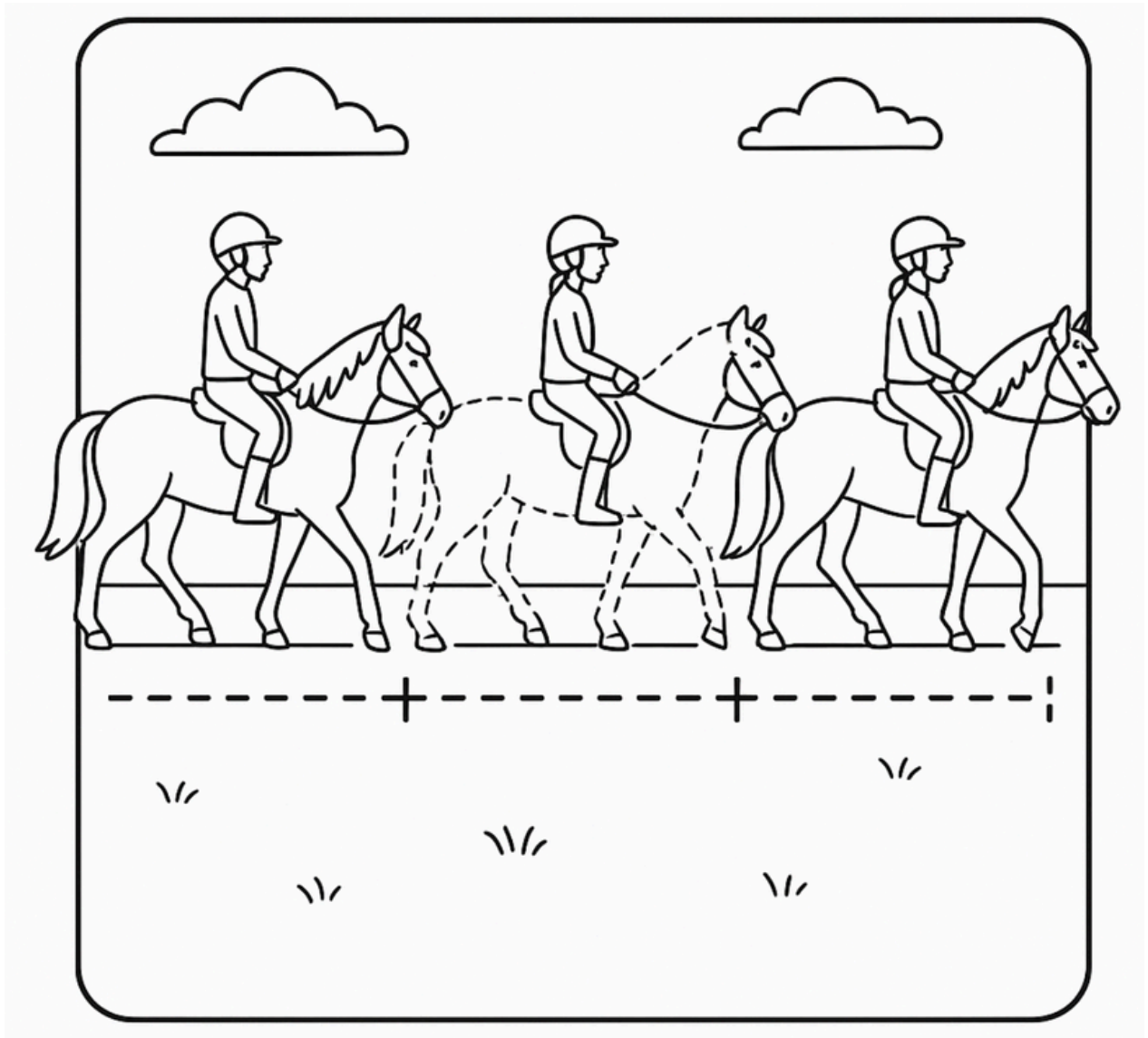
