colostrum which protects and stimulates their immune system. Most are housed individually for the first few weeks of their lives. This reduces the spread of germs and provides individual care.
Dairy feeders are male castrated calves that are raised

for beef. They are now fed a mixture of grains and hay to help them grow into market ready steers.
