- According to a recent Cornell
 University study, the dairy
 industry has reduced the carbon

 programs, cow comfort, and
 overall farm management
 practices.
 - In 1944 a cow produced 2 gallons of milk per day. Today a dairy cow produces 8 gallons of milk per day.
