- "Lamb" is used to define sheep meat from an animal that is less than 1 year of age, "mutton" defines meat from sheep over 1 year of age. Lamb has a milder flavor than mutton.
- Lamb contains many vitamins, minerals and protein. Some favorite lamb products are leg of lamb, kabobs, lamb chops and rack of lamb.
- In addition to meat, sheep also produce the premiere natural fiber, wool, and some breeds are also known for their milk which is often made into cheese.
- Consumer products using sheep byproducts include lanolin, instrument strings, rug pads, carpets, candles, ceramics, dish soap, dog food and many more.
