## General Rules for Horse Show and Clinic

- This event will follow Michigan State 4-H Horse Show rules for all youth exhibiting. Youth do not need to be 4-H members to participate.
- Camping is available for the weekend. Campers must arrive no earlier than Friday June 19<sup>th</sup> at 9 AM and must be hauled out no later than midnight on Sunday June 21<sup>st</sup>. There is no charge for camping and there are electrical hookups available on a first come basis.
- Horses are not allowed on the east and north sides of the horse barn and are not allowed in the camping areas.
- All youth participants in the horse show must participate in the appropriate Fitting and Showing class with each horse they plan to exhibit in the rest of the show. If the youth participant plans to exhibit two horses (example: one in pleasure classes and one in speed) they can bump up an age division with one horse.
- Youth age is determined as the age the youth was on Jan. 1, 2026.
- Youth must be at least 8 years old on Jan. 1, 2026 to participate in the clinic.
- Youth must be at least 5 years old on Jan. 1, 2026 to participate in the show.
- ASTM/SEI Approved Safety Helmets are required for English and Gymkhana Classes for all youth riders and are recommended for all riders.
- A Negative Coggins test, within the previous 12 months, is required upon registration or must be presented to a member of the show committee before the horse is unloaded from the trailer upon arrival at the fairgrounds. Failure to provide proof of a current negative Coggins test will result in the horse being asked to leave the show grounds.
- Pre-registration is required to participate in the clinic. Please fill out the attached registration form and return to the Cheboygan County MSU Extension Office by 4 PM on June 11, 2026.
- Clinic Cost - \$25/day for youth 19 & under, \$75/day for adult participants 20+.
- Class Fee - \$3.00/class for youth 19 & under, \$5.00/class for adults 20+.
- Stalls are available for \$25/stall, \$20 will be refunded when checked clean.
- Ribbons will be awarded through 4<sup>th</sup> place.
- Highpoint and Reserve Awards will be awarded in each division except for 5-7 year olds. Points are totaled on one horse/rider combination, for youth riders with more than one horse, they must select one horse for high point. In-hand trail does not count toward high point.
- Exhibitors should be dressed appropriately to work with horses for the clinic. This includes boots. Exhibitors should be dressed appropriately to show their horses at the show, including boots for all events.
- A horse and rider pair that is in a walk/trot class cannot participate in any walk/trot/canter classes.
- Walk/Trot riders will be disqualified if they canter in a walk/trot class.
- A horse cannot participate in more than two divisions.
- The show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes and the judges' decision is final.
- The judge/show committee reserves the right to ask any rider to dismount and/or leave the premises if their conduct is unsafe.
- Parents are responsible for the safety of their children and equipment.
