- Note: Each year keep the pages from this record book in a binder as this is a progressive project record book and should illustrate the knowledge you have gained over the years in your project area. Record Books can be picked up from the MSU Extension Office after reviewing takes place.

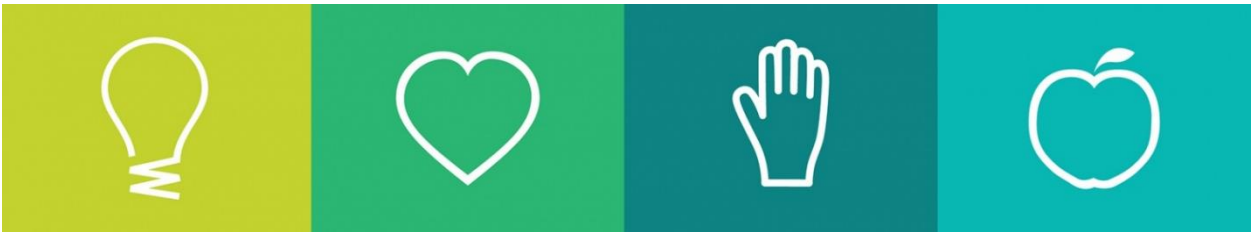
