Aquatic Animal Health Lab Tour with Dr. Tom Loch:



Where to meet: This tour will occur at the University Research Containment Facility, where parking is extremely limited. Therefore, we will be providing round trip transportation between MSU's Parking Ramp #5 and the Containment Facility. Parking Ramp #5 (https://maps.msu.edu/interactive/index.php) is accessed from Red Cedar Road, and is just south of the Communication and Arts Building on campus. Tour attendees should park in Ramp #5, pay for their parking in the northeast corner, ground level of the garage (\$2 per hour; see the white '\$' in map above). From there, walk outside the ramp and meet at the northwest corner of the nearby surface parking lot. Dr. Loch and the shuttle will be waiting for you there. The shuttle will return to Parking Ramp #5 by 9:00 AM.

What to know: Please be aware that no food or beverages are allowed in the containment facility. Also, attendees should have no exposed skin below the waist, meaning generally, that folks should wear long pants and closed-toe shoes.
