
FW101 Lab electrofishing in the Red Cedar River, lead by Dr. Dan Hayes and Dr. Katie LaCommare.



Where to meet: Folks observing the FW 101 Lab Electrofishing Outing should meet on the north side of the Red Cedar River just upstream of the bridge that crosses the river, linking Spartan Stadium and the MSU library. Nearby parking is available in surface lot 62W, which is just north of IM West (https://maps.msu.edu/interactive/index.php), and a few minutes walk to the electrofishing site. Lots 79, 51, 54 and 63 also have visitor parking spots.

What to know: Of course, take care to stay out of the river as electrofishing is occurring. © Class starts at 8 AM, and instructors Drs. Hayes and LaCommare respectfully ask that between 8-8:30 AM observers watch from a distance as they orient the students to the day's activity. After 8:30, either Dr. Hayes or Dr. LaCommare will be available to answer questions, etc.
