
Molecular and Evolutionary Ecology Research Lab with Dr. Sam Brunner:



Where to meet: This tour will occur in Room 27 of the Natural Resources Building, located in the basement level of the building. The closest parking ramp is MSU's Parking Ramp #5 (https://maps.msu.edu/interactive/index.php), which is accessed from Red Cedar Road, and is about a 5 minute walk to the Natural Resources Building. Tour attendees should park in Ramp #5, pay for their parking in the northeast corner, ground level of the ramp (\$2 per hour; see the white '\$' in map above). From there, attendees should walk to the southeast entrance of the Natural Resources Building off Farm Lane (see red asterisk in map above), and head downstairs and down the hall to Room 27.

What to know: Please be aware that no food or beverages are allowed in the lab (although there will be a table outside where you could place your coffee). Attendees should wear closed-toe shoes. The lab is not handicap accessible.
