You may start stalling your livestock starting at 9 am Sunday. Weigh in will take place after all animals are stalled with times to be determined by superintendent and posted by July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Please follow the marked unloading path and note you will **only be able to unload livestock at this time.** After your livestock is unloaded, please pull your truck and trailer away from the barns, and off the midway.

You are encouraged to set up your stall Saturday night before bringing livestock in.

Pictures of pig(s) with their pink tag in their ear and a completed form are due to the MSU Extension office by May 17, 2024. Office staff must be able to read the numbers located on the pink tags.
