



Tuscola County 4-H Council Youth or Leadership Support Request Guide

This basic guide may be used to formulate steps to request financial assistance from the Tuscola 4-H Council.

1. Your request will need to be added to 4-H Council meeting agenda by contacting the 4-H program coordinator or the 4-H council president, at least 3 days prior to scheduled meeting date. Attending the meeting in person (or zoom) is preferred. The earlier we are notified the better and anticipate a response at the next 4-H council meeting.
2. Be prepared to present to the 4-H council on what type of support you are seeking. Please include as many details as possible including event or item information, cost, price comparisons if applicable, receipts if reimbursement.
3. Expect to answer questions on your request. Focus on how this support will benefit your club, community, country or world. Please include how you will be using your Head, Heart, Hands and Health.
4. Please note, funds are rewarded as available with multiple factors taken into consideration. 4-H council representative will follow up with each request presented.
