HOW IT WORKS

It's a mix between speed-dating and a trade show!

- Buyers are stationed at tables around the room, and farmers and suppliers will rotate to meet with buyers of their choice.
- When the event starts, suppliers should find a buyer they would like to meet.
- Make introductions, ask questions, and exchange information. Then do it again with as many people you would like to meet.
- Be aware of the time and of others wanting to meet the person you are speaking with.
- Suppliers – you want to keep moving! This event is meant to build new relationships that extend beyond the night.
