

Food hubs are centrally located facilities with a business management structure facilitating the aggregation, storage, processing, distribution, and/or marketing of locally/regionally food products (USDA-AMS working definition).

#### The CRFS and MDARD Partnership

CRFS and the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD) are partnering to integrate food hub and regional food commerce resources to help Michigan regional food and farm businesses succeed. The key resources in this partnership are 1) seed funding (from MDARD and other sources), 2) coordinated technical assistance (across organizations), and 3) a Michigan Food Hub and Regional Food Commerce Learning and Innovation Network led by CRFS in collaboration with Morse Marketing Connections, LLC.


