

2025 Ingham County 4-H State Horse Show Delegate Process

REQUIRED CRITERIA

- ✓ Be a registered Ingham Co. 4-H member, 12-19
- ✓ Complete Exhibitor Horse/Pony form
- ✓ Complete a State Show Application
- ✓ Volunteer ≥4 hours
- ✓ Take the written test: 1-10 points
- ✓ Show your horse in qualifying shows and classes: earn points from your top 8 classes, and/or participate in IC4H Twilight shows

Open Shows with classes eligible for State Show qualifying points:

- **4-H Leaders Show** – Fri-Sat, June 20-21 (Gymkhana Friday, full show bill Saturday.)
- **CHUM Open Show** – Fri-Sat, June 27-28
- **CHUM Dressage Show** – Sun, June 29 (pre-registration required by June 15)
- **IC4H Twilight Shows** (participation points):
 - Tues. May 27
 - Tues. June 10
 - Tues. July 8

RULES

1. Rider 12-19 years old must be a registered Ingham County 4-H member and completed an Exhibitor Horse /Pony Registration Form by June 1, including Coggins and pictures. Walk Trot exhibitors are not eligible.
2. Horse changes may be requested up to Leaders Show, in the event of a horse injury or death. A new State Show application, Exhibitor Horse/Pony Registration form, coggins, pictures, veterinary statement and letter requesting a change must be submitted to the State Show Delegate Committee for approval.
3. **State Show Application:**
 - a. Complete form by June 1 and submit with Exhibitor Horse/Pony Registration form. One horse per rider.
4. **Volunteer Hours:**
 - a. 4 hours minimum of community service between September 2024 and the 2025 Leaders Show.
 - b. Submit completed State Show Volunteer Hour Log by June 21 to 4-H office or Leaders Show office.
5. **Written Test** of Horse Science, Horsemanship and Rules knowledge.
 - a. Test to be given during Horse Camp on Thursday, June 19 at 6:00 p.m.
 - b. There will be a make-up test event offered for extenuating circumstances. You must request a make-up test with the State Show Delegate Committee no later than June 19.
 - c. 1 to 10 points. See Ingham County 4-H Horse Handbook for point scale.
6. **Shows & Points:**
 - a. Overall top 8 classes to be calculated per rider at the Leaders Show, CHUM Open Show and Dressage show.
 - b. Class points: ≥6 riders per class: 1st place receives 6 points with 6th place receiving 1 point. When less than 6 riders the point max will be set at the number of riders present (e.g., if a class has 3 riders, 1st place will receive 3 points with 3rd receiving 1 point).
 - c. Eligible classes for Gymkhana: Barrels, Flags, Down & Back, Speed & Action, Poles and Keyhole.
 - d. Eligible classes for Performance: Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Ranch Riding, Ranch Horse Pleasure, Trail*, and Dressage Seat Equitation. (*in-hand trail is not eligible).
 - e. Eligible classes for Dressage: Training Level Test 1, 2 & 3, First level Test 1, 2 & 3, Western Basic Level 1 & 4. Western Level 1, Test 1. Intro Level and musical freestyle are not eligible classes.
 - i. Only 2 dressage test placings will be calculated in top 6 overall classes for points.
 - f. Bonus Points for participating at the Twilight shows of 2 points per show.
7. **Delegate Selection:** State Show Delegate Committee will verify criteria has been met and calculate points from the written test, top 8 classes and Twilight show participation. State Show Delegates will be announced and notified no later than July 9. Delegates will receive electronic application and link to registration at that time.
 - a. Per Michigan 4-H Extension, the Ingham County quota for delegates for **2025 is 20 riders**.
 - i. The top 20 riders qualify as Delegates. 4 alternates with the next highest point totals will be identified if one or more of the delegates is unable to compete at the State 4-H Horse Show.
 - ii. State show delegates must submit appropriate paperwork online and payment by July 15, 11.59 p.m.

When is it?

Thursday, August 14, 2025 – 12-19 yrs. Ranch, Reining, etc

Friday, August 15, 2025 – 12-19 yrs. Gymkhana

Saturday, August 16, 2025 – 16-19 yrs. Senior: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Trail, Dressage and 12-19 yrs.

Sunday, August 17, 2025 – 12-15 yrs. Junior: Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Trail, Dressage

Who can participate? Registered Ingham County 4-H members ages 12-19 that are identified as Delegates and meet the criteria.

How do I become a Delegate for Ingham Co?

1. Exhibitor must submit an Exhibitor Horse/Pony Registration form & State Show Application by June 1.
2. Must complete a minimum of 4 volunteer hours in the current program year and submit documentation.
3. Must take the State Show Written Test.
4. Exhibitors compete at qualifying shows and their top eight (8) placing/point will be used to calculate State Show points from designated classes. Bonus Points will be awarded for participating in Twilight Shows.
5. The top 20 exhibitors, based on meeting all criteria and points earned, will represent Ingham County as delegates to compete at the MI State 4-H Horse Show.
