

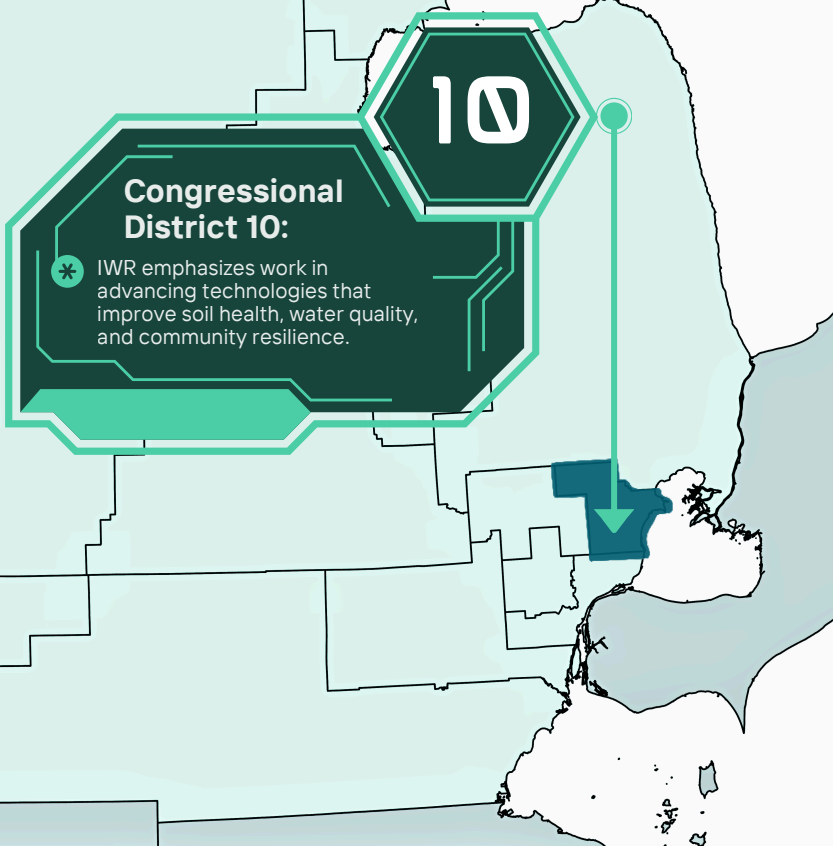


# Congressional District 10

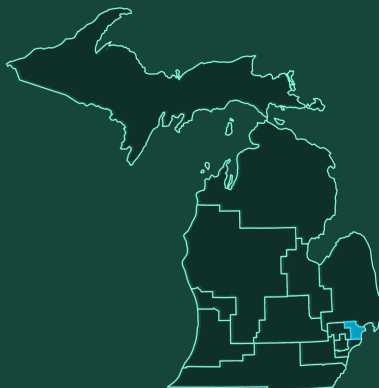

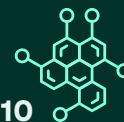
