  - a. Applied to the youth's registration by 4-H staff. This requires a scholarship code at the time of registration for the event. Please reach out to 4-H staff prior to registration to receive this code.
  - b. Reimbursed to the family following registration when the family pays in full.
4. There will be ten - \$100.00 scholarships awarded during each programming year.
