Introduction

Welcome to the second annual Eastern Michigan State Fair Livestock Skillathon! In conjunction with Lapeer County 4-H, we are excited to offer this opportunity to all youth exhibitors. We have gathered a variety of knowledge based questions for the nine species shown at the fair plus general livestock knowledge.

Livestock Skillathon Contests provide a valuable educational experience for youth. The content of these contests provide a framework for youth to learn a variety of topics related to the production and management of beef cattle, meat goats, sheep, swine, rabbits, poultry, dairy cattle and horses. Participants in these events will learn about different breeds of livestock, external parts of livestock, skeletal anatomy of livestock, feedstuffs used in livestock diets, equipment used in raising and showing livestock and in processing meat and much more.

We encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to learn more about species you have never shown or learn more about species you have shown.

Rules and Contest Information

Please review the following rules for participating in the Livestock Skillathon:

- Open to any Eastern Michigan State Fair exhibitor.
- Any specific rules will be outlined at the testing site.
- Skillathon will be held during check-in from 2pm-5pm only. *No tests given out after 4:30 unless previously arranged*
- Results will be announced at the completion of sweepstakes on Saturday.
- Prizes will be awarded in each age category (Advanced Senior, Senior, Intermediate, Junior) with Overall awards for High Point Junior (Most points of Junior and Intermediate Tests) and High Point Senior (Most points of Senior and Advanced Senior Tests).
- There is also a non-competitive Cloverbud test and each cloverbud will receive a prize.
- The skillathon will include a written test consisting of questions related to any of the species shown at the fair (Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Sheep, Swine, Goats, Rabbits, Poultry, Horses, and Dogs). The skillathon contest may also be comprised of practical tests such as breed, feed, or meat cut identification. Contestants may not talk to each other. Questions for information or clarification of instructions should be directed to group leaders or officials. If contestants are caught talking or cheating, they will be removed from the contest.
