- Saturday, August 17, 2024 All Senior Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Trail, Dressage, and all ages Western Riding
- Sunday, August 18, 2024 All Junior Showmanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Trail, and Dressage
- Each Delegate slot may only compete one of the above events. You are able to arrive the night before (generally after 6:30 PM) and must depart 1/2 hour after your last class concludes.
- Also available: Friday, August 17, 2024: Miniature Horse; Sunday, August 18, 2024: P.E.P.

 - Reminder that youth showing Miniature Horses do NOT count against Delegate Slots.

Where is it?

• This event is held at the MSU Pavilion on the Michigan State University campus.

Who can participate?

- Registered Oakland County 4-H members ages 13 19 that are identified as Delegates.
- Junior Exhibitor 13-15 years old
- Senior Exhibitor 16-19 years old
- Miniature Horse Exhibitor 11-19 years old

Why would I want to do this?

- To represent Oakland County's finest Exhibitors.
- To get to know other 4-H Exhibitors from all around Michigan.

How do I get to be a Delegate?

- You must meet the 2024 Oakland County Eligibility Criteria (see back)
- Oakland County has a limited number of Delegates that can participate. A Selection Criteria has been created in the event there are more eligible Oakland 4-H Exhibitors that want to attend than we have Delegate positions.
