Teens 4-H age 16 or over are eligible to participate in the Oakland County 4-H Horse Camp Counselor-in-Training program at Horse Camp, June 16 to June 20, 2024. CIT's (Counselors in Training) will lead teams of campers and participate in crafts, games, and other fun activities. Adult volunteers will be available to assist during these activities.

CITs receive a \$100 scholarship for horse camp! You and your horse will attend classes and gain leadership and mentoring experience as a CIT! Mandatory training prior to camp will prepare you for this position. Training topics include: horsemanship safety, communication, behavior management, team building and leadership skills. The learning experiences you take from the training and your role at camp can be added to your 4-H portfolio or resume.
