



## Berlin 4-H Livestock Committee

### Market Project Record Book Requirements

All 4-H members participating in a market project class at the Berlin Fair are required to complete a Michigan 4-H Market Animal Project Record Book for each market project they plan to show. Record books must be turned in and judged during still exhibit judging the week of the fair.

- **4-H members must complete a record book for each market animal species the 4-H'er is exhibiting.** Example: if you are showing a lamb & rabbit, you must complete two (2) separate record books.
- **All 4-H members must complete one (1) supplement page** from the following list, with all **3 questions answered** (regardless of their age division).
  - Animal Science
  - Biological Science
  - Career Exploration
  - Character
  - Civic Engagement
  - Communication and Expressive Arts
  - Consumer and Family Science
  - Engineering and Technology
  - Environmental and Earth Science
  - Food and Nutrition
  - Health and Safety
  - Leadership and Service
  - Life Skills
  - Plant Science
- 4-H members complete the appropriate record book based on their 4-H age, and the showmanship class the 4-H member will be participating in. Example: if a member is 10 years old (on January 1<sup>st</sup>) and is showing in the Novice Class (showing for the very first time), they should complete the beginner record book.
  - **Novice/Juniors** complete the beginner record book
  - **Intermediates** complete the intermediate record book
  - **Seniors** complete the advanced record book
