

Strengths: Resistant to tuber late blight, common scab, and soft rot. Mountain Gem Russet has acceptable fry quality in 48°F storage with processing potential, and a high percent of U.S. No. 1 tubers.

Weaknesses: Susceptible to shatter bruise, growth crack, PVY, and foliar late blight. This variety has a shorter dormancy, approximately 120 days at 42°F.


UTILIZATION

Mountain Gem Russet is a medium maturing fresh and processing russet potato variety suitable for production above the 45th parallel in Michigan. It has a larger tuber size profile and lower tuber set, with the potential for oversized tubers and higher hollow heart incidence under high nitrogen conditions. Growers can use a Silverton Russet nutrient management strategy to manage tuber size.
