## Congratulations!

Two MSU labs receive funding for continued COVID-19 wastewater monitoring

Two MSU labs will receive nearly \$6 million for projects to conduct COVID-19 wastewater surveillance and testing.

The funding is part of a \$49 million grant, supporting 19 local projects from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), to continue wastewater surveillance in areas statewide. Wastewater is tested for the SARS-CoV-2 virus, which causes COVID-19 disease that is shed in feces into Michigan public sewer systems.

Joan Rose's <u>Water Quality and Environmental Microbiology Laboratory</u> and Irene Xagoraraki's <u>Environmental Virology Laboratory</u> each received funding. Rose's lab will serve as the lead laboratory, responsible for standardizing lab testing and providing technical assistance. Her lab will receive \$3.2 million and Xagoraraki's lab will receive \$2.7 million.

## **COVID-19 Updates**

- ➤ Beginning August 1st, all campus buildings will be open during regular business hours.
- ➤ Offices that have student and public facing operations are expected to be staffed beginning August 16<sup>th</sup>.
