- Applications must be fully completed for consideration.
- Scholarship applications are reviewed at the monthly council meeting. It is the member's responsibility to submit their scholarship application to 4-H Council prior to the event, preferably no less than one month before the event happens. It is recommended that the member submits their scholarship application at the same time that they submit their registration for the event.
- The 4-H member is required to pay the deposit for the event when they register. 4-H Council scholarships will be applied to the balance only after the deposit is made, and when possible, at the conclusion of the event. Scholarships are typically 50% of the event cost, but may vary. Note the scholarship may not cover the entire event and/or balance due.
- In the event that the 4-H member does not attend the workshop, all scholarships will be revoked and the member will be responsible for full payment of the registration and/or cancellation fee, up to and including repayment to 4-H Council for any prepaid fees. If you must cancel your registration for an event, please be sure to contact the MSU Extension office at the earliest date possible to ensure the least cost is incurred.
- All scholarship recipients are encouraged to write a thank you note to 4-H Council sharing what was learned through the experience. Members may be asked to attend a 4-H Council meeting and/or to prepare a presentation to report on their trip,.
- The 4-H member agrees to work a non-Fair weekend in the 4-H Food stand for one or two 4-hour shifts, dependent on the value of scholarship.
