

Shiawassee County Small Animal Association Scholarship

The Shiawassee County Small Animal Association (SCSAA) will present a scholarship of at least \$250 to a young adult who is currently a member of a Shiawassee County Small Animal Exhibitor or FFA Chapter (this award may be split at the committee's discretion). The scholarship is designed to help youth further their education and pursue a career of their choosing after high school. The scholarship can be used to attend any 4-year institution, 2-year college or trade school of the member's choice. This scholarship is not based on a minimum GPA nor is it income based. It is a non-renewable award.

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship, youth must:

- ◆ Be a current and in good standing as a Shiawassee County Small animal exhibitor or in a FFA Chapter.
- ◆ Be a high school senior or in your first 2 years of college.
- ◆ Have proof of acceptance into a college or trade school.
- ◆ Have exhibited Small Market Animals at the Shiawassee County Fair for 3 years

To apply for the scholarship, you must:

- ◆ Complete the SCSAA scholarship form. If typed, nothing small than 12 point font.
- ◆ You must utilize only the space provided. Pages can not be added.
- ◆ Submit at least two letters of recommendation from non-related persons such as a pastor, teacher, employer of which one must be from a 4-H leader, FFA advisor or 4-H agent.
- ◆ Submit all application materials by **May 1st** to **SCSAA, 149 E. Corunna Ave. Corunna, Mi 48817** or **valdezm3@msu.edu**

The selection committee will:

- ◆ Carefully review your application and all attachments.
- ◆ Consider references provided.
- ◆ Select scholarship recipient or recipients.
- ◆ Present the scholarship at the auction.

If you are selected to receive the scholarship:

- ◆ You must submit a receipt of payment for tuition, books or board.
- ◆ Your check will then be issued and sent to you.
