St. Joseph County 4-H High Point Award

- A. Awards will be for Grand and Reserve Champion plus additional Top 3 (Top 5 total) in the following age groups: 13-19 year olds and 8-12 year olds.
- B. Fair and Horse Council-sponsored show classes are counted for the award. The top five (5) placings will count for the award. Points are accumulated in the following classes: Bareback, Horsemanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunt Seat Pleasure, Saddle Seat Equitation, Saddle Seat Pleasure, Showmanship, Trail, Western Pleasure, and Western Riding.
- C. Points are tabulated as follows and are not pro-rated: Six (6) placings for Horse Council sponsored shows and eight (8) placings for fair. In the event of a tie, the committee will count the number of 1st places received. If a tie remains, 2nd places will be counted and so on.
- D. Awards change each year. Examples: Leather Horse Halter, Clothing Bag.
- E. Six different donors that can change year by year no long term donation obligation.
- F. Points will be counted by the 4-H Horse Council tabulation/point committee. 4-H Horse Council President will confirm all tallied points.
- G. Walk/Trot classes do not count toward this award.
