St. Joseph County 4-H Scrapbooking Guidelines



Scrapbooking is defined as a popular leisure activity that involves a very creative preservation and display of photographs, news clippings, certificates, etc. in a scrapbook.

Preservation of photos, news clippings, etc. is done by placing items on acid-free paper using photo mounts, photo corners or glue and adding accessories whether it is done by pens, stickers, etc. Although it is not required, it is recommended that acid-free materials be used. It is required that the sheet protectors be used.

<u>Age Groups</u>	<u>Minimum Page Requirements</u>	<u>Maximum</u>
8-11 years old	10	12
12-14 years old	12	14
15-19 years old	16	20

General Requirements:

- 1. Neatness
- 2. Creativity: including use of stickers, die cuts, cropped photos, etc.
- 3. Journalizing: a brief summary of page or events.
- 4. Not limited to photos: include ribbons, certificates, news clippings, etc.
- 5. Title page: with name, age, year & theme.
- 6. Minimum of 10 pages (depending on age group) put in 5 sheet protectors (back-to-back i.e. 10 sheets = 5 protectors), maximum of 20 pages.
- 7. Binder must be 12" X 12" or smaller.

Theme Examples (be creative):

Broad Themes	Specific Themes

Vacation	Specific sport
Growing up	Family Reunion
Pets	My cat
