AFTERNOON SESSIONS:

Smart Farm/Precision Ag

This session will introduce several interesting new tools and technologies that can assist fruit and vegetable growers with operational tasks or decision making on the farm. From hard tech that you can see in the field to soft tech you can use on your smartphone. Presenters will provide a glimpse into some tech options available here in Michigan.

Pesticides, Regulation & Compliance

Staying Ahead in Crop Protection: Strategies, codes, and best practices. Join us for a RUP topic heavy session! We will hear from representatives from CTAP (Conservation Technical Assistance Program), IR-4, MSU Pesticide Safety and MSU Extension.

DAY 2:

TREE FRUIT:

This year's tree fruit program emphasizes how growers can move the industry forward through targeted marketing, effective use of marketing, and practical approaches to the current labor landscape. In addition, there will be IPM topics, with a focus on current strategies for managing diseases, weeds, and insect pests in orchards.

GRAPES:

We will have an all-day session on various topics for grape growers. Trial results and research outlook at SWMREC will be discussed. Other topics will include pest and disease updates, regenerative viticulture, and the finalization of a new Sub-AVA in southwest Michigan, among others.

STRAWBERRIES and BLUEBERRIES:

This year we will expand our small fruit education to include topics outside of blueberries! The morning session on Day 2 will be a mixture of strawberry and blueberry education with the afternoon focusing solely on blueberries.
