JOIN AN EXISTING CLUB:

TAKE A LOOK AT WHAT OUR CLUBS HAVE TO OFFER IN WASHTENAW COUNTY. CONTACT THE CLUB LEADER DIRECTLY TO SEE IF THAT CLUB WILL BE A GOOD MATCH FOR YOUR FAMILY. NOT ALL CLUBS OFFER ALL PROJECTS, SO FIND A CLUB THAT OFFERS LEADERSHIP IN THE PROJECT AREA THAT MEETS YOUR INTERESTS.

START YOUR OWN CLUB:

ALL YOU NEED IS 5-10 KIDS AND TWO ADULT VOLUNTEERS TO ORGANIZE THE CLUB. CHOOSE THE AREAS OF INTEREST AND MEETING TIMES. OUR 4-H STAFF WILL HELP YOU GET STARTED.

DECIDE ON A PROJECT:

HIPPOLOGY IS THE STUDY OF ALL HORSE-RELATED KNOWLEDGE, INCLUDING JUDGING, ANATOMY, BREEDS, COLORS, CARE, EQUIPMENT, TACK, HEALTH AND WELFARE, AND RIDING DISCIPLINES. HORSE JUDGING IS YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO BECOME THE JUDGE AND PLACE HORSES BASED ON CONFORMATION (HALTER) AND PERFORMANCE (RIDING).
