Friday Night after Sweepstakes	CLEAN UP: ALL CLUBS – send one helper for every 10 members, (minimum one). 1.) Break-down gates & take to outside wash rack area. 2.) Use power washers to clean all gates. (Create a system) 3.) After all gates are cleaned, stack neatly in a row, on pallets, down the center of wash rack with pallets open to entryway, so pallets can be picked up by machinery early Saturday morning.

* During this time exhibitors using any wash rack must carefully clean up after themselves.

EVERYONE – While on duty, club members are responsible for double-checking that the wash rack between building C and D is clean, please also check the wash rack between D and E. We recommend cleaning the wash rack at the start of your shift, and again every hour you are on duty. Youth do not need to stand on duty on the wash rack during their entire shift, but are responsible for assuring the area is clean. Please help keep our wash racks clean for visitors and fellow exhibitors. Although specific clubs are responsible for time slots, the **owners are expected to clean up after their own animals!!** ****Please use the sign in sheet near the wash rack to check in and check out during your Wash Rack Duty. This helps make sure that everyone is contributing equally.****
