4-H CAPITOL EXPERIENCE

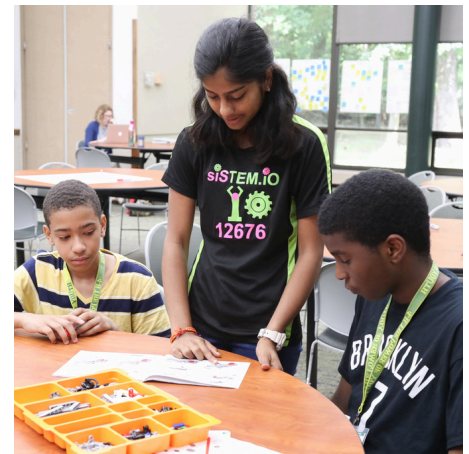
